## **MLC Written Answer**

#### **Statistics**

- 1875 Candidates
  - 4337 in Fall 2013, 3078 in Spring 2013
- MC score to have written answer graded 12 of 20 (1480 papers)
  - Some papers below 12 also graded provided confidence that 12 was the correct cutoff
  - No paper scoring 12 or below had a total score that met the pass mark

#### Notes

- Written answer provided discrimination beyond multiple choice
  - Some papers with low MC scores passed
  - Some papers with high MC scores failed
- Model solutions will be published
- More graders needed for Fall

#### Advice

- Pay attention to verbs
  - Read the Guide to Written Answer Exams
- Pay attention to point values
  - Indicates amount of time expected; guides the amount of detail to provide
- Use model solutions as more than an indication of how to work the problem

- Simulates (though not perfectly) CBT experience
- Topics, but not difficulty, randomized

#### **CBT performance feedback**
